

ONE ANOTHER WORKSHEET

Accompanies One Anothers Scripture List

John 13:34-35: A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another.

1. Read through the One Anothers Scripture List.
 - a. What do you sense the Lord highlighting for you out of these Scriptures?
 - b. Are there any common themes to these Scriptures?
 - c. Is there any action you sense the Lord prompting you to take?
2. What did Jesus mean when He said, "As I have loved you..."
 - a. How has Jesus loved you?
 - b. How did Jesus demonstrate the type of love the Lord is asking you to walk in? (From 1.c.)
3. In the past and present, how have your responses to others **not** demonstrated the love of Jesus?
 - a. What habits of selfishness does the Lord want to change in you?
 - b. In what ways have your responses been impatient, angry, resentful, vengeful, etc.
 - c. Confess these things and ask God to help you love the way He loves.
4. Ask the Holy Spirit to highlight one Scripture for you from the One Anothers Scripture List.
 - a. Slowly read and speak this Scripture out loud three times.
 - b. What do you sense the Lord speaking to you through this Scripture?
5. In what ways is God asking you to walk and live in more love for others?
 - a. How will you continue to walk in faith rather than slipping back into old patterns?
6. Praise God for what He has done for you. Jesus is King!
